APPEARANCE

Toltecatl (tol-teh-cat) is a young Aztec male with a tanned complexion, broad shoulders and a well proportioned physique. He has short black hair and dark brown eyes. His ears have been pierced and he wears small earrings carved from stone. In times of war (or during ceremonial events), he wears a tight fitting cotton body suit called a tlahuizli. His tlahuizli is blue with black spots and the helmet is shaped like a

jaguar's head. Since joining Lord Marco with his travels, he has taken to wearing loose fitting contemporary clothing. Even then, he often has an obsidian dagger tucked into his belt.

PERSONAL GOALS

Toltecatl is dedicated to Lord Marco for saving his life and will do anything to see no harm comes to him. When he has a chance, he likes to collect rocks from his travels that he later carves into various trinkets.

PERSONALITY

Toltecatl is a man of action with nerves of steel. He is brave and always faces adversity head on. His bravery is matched by his sense of honour. He is a veteran of several war campaigns but now he prefers to live up to his name (which means 'artist') by carving stone (like his father). He is loyal to his friends and once he gives his word, he stands by it. Toltecatl's manner is often blunt and forward. He speaks what is on his mind without mincing words.

BACKGROUND

Toltecatl is an Aztec warrior who has worked his way up within the army ranks due to his fighting skill and courage. His father was a simple stone carver who wanted his son to follow in his footsteps but the excitement and the chance of advancement, both socially and financially, called to Toltecatl instead. He joined the army of the Triple Alliance (three tribes of Mexica people who formed one city-state). He distinguished himself on the field of battle against the Triple Alliance's enemies, the Culhuacan people/city-state. He was awarded his jaguar tlahuizli and many precious stones for his actions during the battle.

Unfortunately, Toltecatl's father died in an accident before he had a chance to hear of his son's success. Toltecatl used his newly found wealth to bury his father with the finest goods so his father would be able to offer them to Mictlantecuhtli (the god of the dead) when his spirit arrived at the Underworld.

He had taken up stone carving with much enthusiasm as he tries to leave the violence of war behind him. He has travelled into the hills in search for the finest rocks to carve. During this trip, he encountered the Time Lord known as Marconollavirandavashi who was searching for an alien presence that was meddling in local affairs by masquerading as the Mexica god of bats, Camazotz. Toltecatl befriended the Time Lord and helped him defeat the alien menace. Afterwards, Toltecatl joined Lord Marco and became one of his travelling companions.
