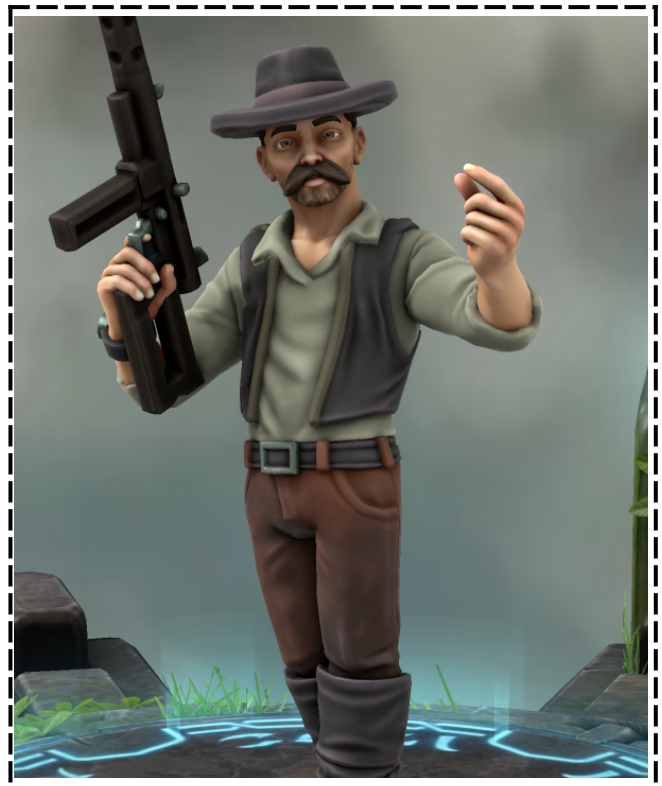
Place of Birth: Leipzig, Germany
